Job retention services to reduce the expense of turnover rates by assessing needs and recommending solutions for employees at risk of losing a job because of a physical or mental condition.

Accessibility assessments and solutions to evaluate the circumstances which may create barriers to employing people or serving customers with disabilities.

On-the-job training to reimburse you a percentage of a DRS consumer's wages and workers' compensation costs, while preparing the trainee for employment.

Consultations about tax incentives, work processes, productivity improvements, specialized training on disability etiquette and diversity, and workplace accommodations for employees with disabilities.
